ATLANTIS CITY WATER POLO AND AQUATICS CLUB INC ATHLETE'S CODE OF CONDUCT

As an Atlantis City Water Polo and Aquatics Club (**Atlantis City**) athlete you agree to abide by this Code of Conduct. In particular, during any activity associated to Atlantis City (whether during competition or otherwise) you will:

- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of others.
- Be fair, considerate and honest in all dealings with others.
- Be professional in, and accept responsibility for, your actions.
- Make a commitment to providing a quality performance.
- Be aware of, and operate within, the Constitution, rules, regulations and policies of Atlantis City.
- Be aware of, and operate within, the rules and policies of New Zealand Water Polo and FINA.
- Understand the possible consequences of breaching this Code of Conduct (which may include suspension from competition or expulsion from a team or from the Club).
- Immediately report any breaches of this Code of Conduct by any Atlantis City members to the Club Secretary.
- Refrain from any form of abuse towards others.
- Refrain from using any obscene language.
- Refrain from any form of harassment towards others.
- Refrain from any form of discrimination towards others.
- Refrain from any form of victimisation towards others.
- Promote the interests of water polo.
- Provide a safe environment for training, playing, competing and travelling with Atlantis City.
- Show concern and caution towards others who may be sick or injured.
- Be a positive role model.
- Not provide comment to any media, or publish any comment (including on any website or in any social media), on behalf of Atlantis City.
- Not speak to any media in a negative way, or publish any negative comment (including on any website or in any social media) regarding Atlantis City.
- Never act in any way that may bring disrepute or disgrace to Atlantis City, or any of its members, stakeholders and/or sponsors, potential sponsors and/or partners.
- Not participate (or benefit from assisting others involved) in sports betting or gambling activity associated with water polo matches and/or water polo results in which you are participating or have been directly involved in.
- Respect that coaches and managers are responsible for the wellbeing of all team members and will make decisions for the good of the team.
