

ATLANTIS CITY WATER POLO AND AQUATICS CLUB INC

Terms and Conditions of Membership

- If a player is selected for a team representing Atlantis City Water Polo and Aquatics Club (ACWPA) they are expected to attend all scheduled trainings for that team unless arrangements to the contrary are agreed with ACWPA's head coach. Failure to attend all such scheduled training may jeopardise that player's place in the team and/or game time.
- Once a player is registered, they will be sent an invoice. Fees are payable within seven days of receipt of invoice. This invoice must be paid before the player may play for the Club. Failure to pay on time may result in cancellation of the player's place in the team. If a debt is sent to a debt collection agency all debt collection fees or legal fees will be at the Club member's own cost.
- The player and their parent/guardian (if the player is younger than 18 years old) agree to abide by all policies and bylaws issued from time to time by ACWPA and published on the ACWPA website.
- ACWPA is not responsible for any personal injury suffered whilst representing ACWPA or taking part in any ACWPA activities.
- Players and/or their parents or guardians (if a player is younger than 18 years old) acknowledge that it is their responsibility to identify any medical issues that need to be known by the player's current coach.
- The Club does not offer family discounts and expects players to attend the majority of all training sessions. Unfortunately the Club's overheads are such that it is unable to offer any discount if a player has other commitments that preclude him/her from taking advantage of all the trainings offered. If a player plays for more than one age group, then they will be charged term fees for the number of training sessions allocated. The number of sessions offered in any given age groups will vary during the course of the year depending on whether it is the age group's off season or on season.
- If a player withdraws from a Term's training in the first four weeks of that Term, he/she will be offered a 50% discount on that Term's fee. However please note that withdrawal from the Term means that that player forfeits his/her place in that age group and, because of its large waiting list, the Club cannot then guarantee that player's place in that age group going forwards. This policy is designed to offer financial compensation for the player no longer being able to play water polo, but also to open the place up to a child who is currently on the Club's waiting list. To guarantee a place for the rest of the season, all training fees must be paid.
- Players and/or their parents or guardians (if the player is younger than 18 years old) agree
 to ACWPA and New Zealand Water Polo photographing or videoing games and/or trainings,
 and using any images captured thereby on their respective websites or in any other media,
 for promotion and publicity of water polo in New Zealand.
